



## SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

*These scholarships are available to students who will be attending an accredited college, university, community college or tech school.*

### **Available Scholarships**

Nemont, serving Northeast Montana, two \$1000 scholarships

- One for a student attending a four-year accredited college or university.
- One for a student attending a two-year accredited community college or trade school.
- Student, parent or guardian must be a customer of Nemont, serving Northeast Montana.

Nemont, serving South Central Montana, two \$1000 scholarships

- One for a student attending a four-year accredited college or university.
- One for a student attending a two-year accredited community college or trade school.
- Student, parent or guardian must be a customer of Nemont, serving South Central Montana.

Nemont, serving Northwest North Dakota, two \$1000 scholarships

- One for a student attending a four-year accredited college or university.
- One for a student attending a two-year accredited community college or trade school.
- Student, parent or guardian must be a current customer of Nemont, serving Northwest North Dakota.

### **Guidelines**

1. Only current customers of Nemont and their dependants may apply for these scholarships.
2. Immediate family members\* of Nemont board members or employees are not eligible to apply.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and are not renewable.
4. Preference may be given to students pursuing a telecommunications career or related field such as marketing, computers, accounting, electronics, etc.
5. Scholarship winners and alternates will be asked to provide a picture for use in company publications and advertising, and a signed release form, within 30 days of notification.

\* Immediate family members referred to are: parents, siblings, children, spouse, grandchildren or the spouse's same immediate family members.

6. Winners must be full-time students enrolling in at least 12 credit hours per semester during the next school year.
7. A minimum of 2.0 Grade Point Average, or “C” average, is required of the scholarship winners during the first semester. The \$1000 scholarship will be awarded after the first semester. If a winner fails to meet the requirement, the scholarship will be forfeited and re-awarded to the “alternate” selected at the time of judging.
8. Scholarship applicants will be required to provide:
  - A copy of their high school or college transcript or GED.
  - Two letters of recommendation.
  - One character reference letter.
  - A brief statement of their future career goals.
  - Scholarship application.

### **Judging**

- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Scholarship judging will be based upon grades, application and school/community involvement.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, age, income, sex or disability.
- Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee composed of Nemont board members and employees.
- The scholarships will be awarded to the successful applicants upon completion of their first semester, and after they have provided an official transcript.

### **Deadline**

- Scholarship applications must be postmarked on, or before, April 3rd.
- Winners and alternates will be notified by mid-May.
